
## Start here!

Matariki Quad – In front of the Matariki Building.

- Puaka James Height
  This building contains the
  university's central library, Te Pātaka
  and the Kaitoko Student advisors,
  IT Services, Academic Study Skill
  Centre. This is also a central hub of
  all student needs including copy
  centre, pharmacy, heat and eat, fast
  food shop, cafes and a restaurant.
- Rata | Engineering Core
  This building has 4 engineering
  wings: Mechanical, Civil, Electrical
  and Computer, Chemical and
  Process Engineering.
- Pou Tama | Ernest Rutherford
  Ernest Rutherford is a part of the
  Science and Innovation Centre,
  and has state of the art teaching,
  learning and research spaces for
  science.
- Rehua
  Rehua is the home to the faculties
  of Education and Health, the Centre
  for Entrepreneurship and executive
  development programmes from the
  UC Business School.
- 5 Forestry Building
  Student Accessibility Services is
  based here to help students
  with learning challenges such as
  dyslexia. Student Experience team is
  also based here and can help match
  students with mentors.
- Te Ao Mārama

  Te Ao Mārama means the world of enlightenment and is the academic home of mātauranga Māori. This whare houses Aotahi School of Māori and Indigenous Studies, Kā Waimaero | Ngāi Tahu Research

  Centre and UC Māori.



Meremere

This building is the centre for Business & Law and hosts a simulated business trading room with a live share market stock ticker. It also has a Moot Room (a mock court room), which was used for real trials by the Canterbury District Court following the Waitaha Canterbury earthquakes.

James Logie / Elsie Locke

Home to the faculty of Arts which offers humanities, language, social & political science, Māori & Indigenous studies and creative digital arts. The Pacific Development team is also based here.

Angus Tait

Home to the Future Students Office. Future Student Advisors can provide advice on degree options. They can assist with information on degrees, scholarships, accommodation, and other aspects of university life.

Recreation Centre

This centre includes indoor squash and basketball courts, rock climbing, fitness classes and a gym. The gym is free for all students.

Whare Hauora Health Centre

The centre has doctors, nurses, and other health specialists.

Haere-roa

This is a space for students to socialise, enjoy amazing events and engage with clubs. This building includes the Ngaio Marsh Theatre, Bentley's Lounge, The Foundry student bar, club facilities and UCSA.
